**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 5019**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 8 through 11 and insert:

- 2 “(1) Agency administration..... \$ 3,266,428  
3 (2) Fire protection..... \$ 52,126,056  
4 (3) Private forests ..... \$ 17,381,378  
5 (4) Debt service ..... \$18,959,910”.

6 Delete lines 18 through 26.

7 On page 2, delete line 1 and insert:

- 8 “(1) Agency administration..... \$ 36,167,602  
9 (2) Fire protection..... \$ 76,617,864  
10 (3) State forests ..... \$ 106,777,017  
11 (4) Private forests ..... \$ 12,992,807  
12 (5) Capital improvement ..... \$ 4,783,787  
13 (6) Debt service ..... \$ 517,590  
14 (7) Equipment pool..... \$ 17,769,354  
15 (8) Facilities maintenance  
16 and management..... \$ 5,642,715”.

17 Delete lines 11 through 24 and insert:

- 18 “(1) Agency administration..... \$ 2,809,548  
19 (2) Fire protection..... \$ 17,756,258  
20 (3) State forests ..... \$ 909,460  
21 (4) Private forests ..... \$ 14,085,636

1       **“SECTION 5. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appro-**  
2 **priation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the**  
3 **biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the follow-**  
4 **ing amounts, to be allocated to the State Forestry Department for the**  
5 **following purposes:**

6       (a) Severity resource expenses..... \$ 4,000,000

7       (b) Catastrophic wildfire  
8             insurance premium expenses.... \$ 2,000,000

9       (c) Supplemental fire program  
10            personnel costs due to  
11            extended fire seasons..... \$ 2,000,000

12       **“(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this**  
13 **section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December**  
14 **1, 2020, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any**  
15 **purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

16       **“SECTION 6. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**  
17 **ation, there is appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the**  
18 **biennium ending June 30, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount**  
19 **of \$3,201,253 for catastrophic wildfire insurance premium costs for the**  
20 **2019 fire season.**

21       **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
22 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter 592,**  
23 **Oregon Laws 2017, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019, as the max-**  
24 **imum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reve-**  
25  **nues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and including federal funds**  
26 **from the United States Forest Service for fire protection and for re-**  
27 **search projects, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not de-**  
28 **scribed in section 2, chapter 592, Oregon Laws 2017, collected or**  
29 **received by the State Forestry Department, for fire protection, is in-**  
30 **creased by \$532,747 for catastrophic wildfire insurance premium costs**

1 for the 2019 fire season.

2 **SECTION 8. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
3 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
4 **declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
