6 In line 18, delete “\$11,433,317” and insert “\$12,533,782”.

7 In line 29, delete “\$14,346,970” and insert “\$14,727,985”.

8 In line 31, delete “\$1,908,386” and insert “\$2,006,234”.

9 In line 41, delete “\$6,092,019” and insert “\$7,838,317”.

10 In line 42, delete “\$4,046,295” and insert “\$4,450,925”.

11 On page 3, line 2, delete “\$10,676,185” and insert “11,075,753”.

14 Delete lines 12 through 14 and insert:

15 **“SECTION 18. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expendi-**
16 **tures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 13 (2),**
17 **chapter 577, Oregon Laws 2017, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019,**
18 **as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or**
19 **other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lot-**
20 **tery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative**
21 **Fiscal Officer, is increased by \$380,000.**

1 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund**
2 **appropriation made to the Legislative Assembly by section 7 (2),**
3 **chapter 577, Oregon Laws 2017, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019,**
4 **is decreased by \$1,000,000.**

5 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund**
6 **appropriation made to the Legislative Assembly by section 6, chapter**
7 **577, Oregon Laws 2017, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019, is in-**
8 **creased by \$1,000,000.**

9 **“SECTION 19. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate**
10 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
11 **declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
