11 **“SECTION 4. The amounts allocated for private activity bonds, as**

13 Index or a change in federal law allows the
14 private activity bond limit as set by the
15 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, to
16 exceed \$440,024,865 during the 2020 calendar
17 year or \$440,024,865 during the 2021 calendar
18 year, the increase is allocated to the Private
19 Activity Bond Committee.

20 **“SECTION 5.** For purposes of Article XI-G, section 1, of the Oregon
21 Constitution, the Legislative Assembly determines that the projects
22 authorized to be financed pursuant to section 1 (1) of this 2019 Act with
23 bonds issued under Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution will ben-
24 efit higher education institutions or activities or community colleges
25 authorized by law to receive state aid.

26 **“SECTION 6.** Bonds authorized under section 1 (1) of this 2019 Act
27 may not be issued until the constructing authority certifies that the
28 constructing authority has matching funds available for the same or
29 similar purposes as the Article XI-G bonds that will fund the grant to
30 the constructing authority, that the match funds are not proceeds of

1 indebtedness incurred by the state under any other article of the
2 Oregon Constitution, and that the match funds are available to the
3 constructing authority in an amount at least equal to the amount of
4 indebtedness incurred by the state through the issuance of the Article
5 XI-G bonds.

6 **“SECTION 7.** Of the proceeds from the lottery revenue bonds au-
7 thorized under section 2 of this 2019 Act, \$6,500,000 may be used to
8 provide the required matching funds in relation to the Article XI-G
9 bonds authorized under section 1 (1)(a) of this 2019 Act.

10 **“SECTION 8.** (1) Out of the amount specified in section 1 (5)(m)(A)
11 of this 2019 Act, the State Treasurer may issue Article XI-Q bonds in
12 an amount not to exceed \$31,500,000 of net proceeds for the purposes
13 and in the manner specified in section 8, chapter 705, Oregon Laws
14 2013, plus an amount estimated by the State Treasurer to pay esti-
15 mated bond-related costs.

16 **“(2)** Out of the amount specified in section 1 (5)(m)(B) of this 2019
17 Act, the State Treasurer may issue Article XI-Q bonds in an amount
18 not to exceed \$87,600,000 of net proceeds for the purposes and in the
19 manner specified in section 8, chapter 705, Oregon Laws 2013, plus an
20 amount estimated by the State Treasurer to pay estimated bond-
21 related costs.

22 **“(3)** Out of the amount specified in section 1 (5)(m)(C) of this 2019
23 Act, the State Treasurer may issue Article XI-Q bonds in an amount
24 not to exceed \$15,900,000 of net proceeds for the purposes and in the
25 manner specified in section 8, chapter 705, Oregon Laws 2013, plus an
26 amount estimated by the State Treasurer to pay estimated bond-
27 related costs.

28 **“(4)** For purposes of sections 8 and 9, chapter 705, Oregon Laws 2013,
29 and section 64, chapter 723, Oregon Laws 2013, bonds issued pursuant
30 to this section are considered to be bonds issued pursuant to section

1 **8, chapter 705, Oregon Laws 2013.**

2 **“(5) Bonds may not be issued pursuant to section 1 (5)(m)(A), (B)**
3 **or (C) of this 2019 Act except as provided in this section.**

4 **“SECTION 9.** Section 1, chapter 570, Oregon Laws 2017, as amended by
5 section 1, chapter 87, Oregon Laws 2018, and section 7, chapter 30, Oregon
6 Laws 2019 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5542), is amended to read:

7 **“Sec. 1.** The amounts authorized, as provided by ORS 286A.035, for issu-
8 ance of general obligation bonds of the state during the 2017-2019 biennium,
9 notwithstanding section 10, chapter 705, Oregon Laws 2013, are as follows:
