- HB 4013 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes regulations for kratom products, including labeling requirements and minimum age for sale.
- HB 4033 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes community lender loan loss account program, authorizing Oregon Business Development Department to enter into contracts with lenders pursuant to which department shall reimburse lenders from moneys in lenders' loan loss accounts for principal financial losses incurred due to default on qualified loans to small Oregon businesses.
- HB 4034 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to establish by rule process to register medical marijuana grow sites.
- HB 4035  
Directs Oregon Health Authority, Oregon Liquor Control Commission, State Department of Agriculture and Governor's office to develop plan to address issues related to regulatory authority over marijuana.
- HB 4088 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to establish Cannabis Social Equity Program to provide discounted recreational marijuana licensure fees and other support to program participants.
- HB 4117  
Authorizes eligible business to deliver malt beverages, wine or cider to final consumer through use of delivery person.
