HB 4015  
Directs Housing and Community Services Department to study laws related to housing and to report to Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2020.

HB 4090  
Authorizes Land Conservation and Development Commission to approve plans for urban growth boundary expansion to accommodate affordable housing in Pendleton.

HB 4095  
Authorizes Department of Land Conservation and Development to approve local governments' plans for urban growth boundary expansion areas that will accommodate affordable housing.

HB 4084 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes Rural System Development Charges Program within Housing and Community Services Department to pay system development charges for rural affordable multifamily housing.

HB 4003 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/10/2020 AGENDA: Authorizes Housing and Community Services Department to provide grants and technical assistance to organizations increasing homeownership program access to persons of color.

HB 4039 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 02/10/2020 AGENDA: Appropriates moneys to Department of Human Services for services provided to unaccompanied homeless youth.

*Note change: the order of the measures has been updated, and HB 4003 and HB 4039 have been carried over from February 10th, 2020.*
