#### Public Hearing

- HB 4121 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/3/2020 AGENDA: Provides that Northern Oregon Regional Correctional Facility may not contract with United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement if Legislative Assembly appropriates, for distribution to facility, specified amount of moneys.
- HB 4040 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Judicial Department to establish Family Treatment Court Program in certain counties to improve outcomes in child welfare cases resulting from parent's or caregiver's alleged substance use disorder.
- HB 4065  
Repeals driving privilege suspension and eliminates imposition of driving privilege restrictions for failure to pay fine.
- HB 4097  
Prohibits police officer from conducting or participating in activities intended to determine whether person has paid certain user charges, fees or tolls imposed by mass transit district.
- HB 4131 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to establish, in collaboration with Department of Corrections, Family Preservation Project pilot program at Coffee Creek Correctional Facility.

Expands membership of Public Defense Services Commission from seven to nine members.
