- HB 4131 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to establish, in collaboration with Department of Corrections, Family Preservation Project pilot program at Coffee Creek Correctional Facility.
- HB 4142
Eliminates minimum amount of fee added to judgment that includes monetary obligation that court or judicial branch is charged with collecting.
- HB 4148
Declares Oregon policy regarding Indian children.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 4126 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Increases penalties for crime of riot if, during commission of riot, person conceals person's face with intent to facilitate commission of riot.
- HB 4145
Creates crime of unlawfully threatening a school or place of worship.

Work Session

- HB 4040 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Judicial Department to establish Family Treatment Court Program in certain counties to improve outcomes in child welfare cases resulting from parent's or caregiver's alleged substance use disorder.
- HB 4107
Makes unlawful practice for place of public accommodation to refuse to accept United States coins or currency as payment for goods and services.
