- HB 4001 A** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Defines "emergency shelter." Requires local governments to allow siting of qualifying emergency shelters notwithstanding land use laws and regulations.
- HB 4015
Directs Housing and Community Services Department to study laws related to housing and to report to Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2020.
- HB 4016 A** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Defines "device" for purposes of practice of advanced nonablative esthetics.
- HB 4033 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/20/2020 2:00 PM AGENDA: Establishes community lender loan loss account program, authorizing Oregon Business Development Department to enter into contracts with lenders pursuant to which department shall reimburse lenders from moneys in lenders' loan loss accounts for principal financial losses incurred due to default on qualified loans to small Oregon businesses.
- HB 4053 A
Removes prohibition against issuing dog license without proof of rabies inoculation.
- HB 4126 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Increases penalties for crime of riot if, during commission of riot, person conceals person's face with intent to facilitate commission of riot.

- HB 4167 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Modifies statewide greenhouse gas emissions reduction goals.
