## **Work Session**

SB 1501

Permits students participating in intercollegiate sports to earn compensation for certain services and for name, image or likeness and to retain professional representation or athlete agent.

SB 1522

Modifies definitions of "sexual conduct" and "student" for purposes of requirements for education providers related to abuse of and sexual conduct toward students.

SB 1539

Designates Oregon Institute of Technology as Oregon's Polytechnic University.

SB 1544

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to adopt by rule additional minimum standards regarding source of tuition revenue for licensing of career schools and schools authorized to confer degrees.

SB 1572

Establishes subject-matter credit requirements that students must satisfy in order to receive high school diploma.
