WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Adjusts the definition of eligible student for free and reduced-price lunches, changes meal programs' reimbursement rate to that established by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and changes the effective date of provisions relating to summer learning programs so that programs may be funded for the summer of 2020. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

House Bill 3427 (2019), the Student Success Act, enacted a modified corporate activity tax and directed the revenue from that tax into the Fund for Student Success (FSS). The FSS funds student investment grants to school districts, early learning programs throughout Oregon, and certain statewide kindergarten through twelfth grade (K-12) programs. Senate Bill 1520 modifies the language of HB 3427 regarding certain statewide programs to better align with federal law and to allow implementation of summer programs in 2020.
