My name is Shannon Vilhauer, and I am the Executive Director of Habitat for Humanity of Oregon. I am writing to express our organization's strong support for HB 4039.

In 2018, Oregon Habitat for Humanity affiliates reached an important milestone: together we have made the dream of stable and affordable homeownership a reality for 2,000 Oregon households. All across the state, Habitat for Humanity Board members, staff, volunteers and future homeowners are rolling up our sleeves to build more affordable homes than ever.

Unfortunately, we can't build our way out of the problem quickly enough to meet the immediate needs of children, families and elders looking for a stable place to call home.
