As a parent I strongly OPPOSE HB 4132. The wellness of children is the concern of parents across the state. Parents, along with the doctors of their choice, should be the only authority on the overall health of said children. It is not the position of the government, or any government entity to monitor and survey the children of this state, nor to use this information to formulate laws.
