We oppose all three of the above bills. The Hemp industry is not established enough to warrant these actions and any associated state costs. Furthermore, the state of Oregon should not be investing funding to develop a sales and production plan!!!!!! That is the function of those who choose to become involved in hemp operations. Other agriculture segments do not have this kind of assistance available to them.

In consideration of any of these bills, we request that protections for EFU, AR and RR lands from hemp processing plants be included.
