In this critical time I wanted to be an adult and find my own way to pay, thinking I could factor the expense into a monthly budget. That lead me to insulin rationing to save money. That is wrong. My out of pocket cost for 30 days of 1 of the 2 types of insulin I need to take everyday is over 500 dollars. Deciding between rent and insulin is not something anyone should face.

Type I Diabetes was passed down to me. There is nothing I could do to prevent this disease but it does not need to be a death sentence. Please, I urge you to vote in support of HB 4073. It will save Oregonians lives.
