Guardian of last resort


- No less restrictive alternative

Clients we serve


- Highly complex and varied

Current Program Status

- Full caseload capacity with current resources was reached in January 2019
 - Unable to accept almost any new cases since January 2019
 - Unable to accept new cases to waitlist since July 2019

3 Veteran Specialist Deputies

- Dedicated caseload for up to 60 Veterans
- Regionally-based to cover all areas of the state
 - Coordinate with local VA and other veteran outreach programs
 - Will become experts on resources within the complicated and bureaucratic VA systems
