Measure Description:

Modifies allocation formula for grants to children's advocacy centers.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Public Universities, Department of Justice (DOJ), Department of Human Services (DHS), Department of Education (ODE), Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure changed requirements around cases of suspected child abuse that the Department of Justice may pay for medical services, including child abuse assessments to a children's advocacy center.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Department of Justice, Department of Education, Public Universities, and the Department of Human Services.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
