Sold in Convenience Stores and other venues where under 21 are allowed

2019 National Youth Tobacco Survey shows vast majority of youth use these style of **small, easily concealable, high nicotine level** products

Not a significant revenue source to small business vapor retail stores

Recent federal action (FDA and HHS) banned flavors in all prefilled pods (Juul), but exempted disposables (PuffBar)

Products are cheap and disposable, as well as high in nicotine content, making them appealing to youth.

Open Systems



Aegis - \$150

UWell - \$175

Sold in retail vape shops where only adults aged 21 and older are allowed

Size of these products and complexity of setup and use makes concealed use of these devices much more difficult

Flavored open systems represent a significant revenue source to small business vapor retail stores (>70%)

Products are expensive, and require refilling and replacement of consumables, making it difficult to use and access for minors.
