On behalf of Providence Health & Services, thank you for the opportunity to voice our support for House Bill 4032 - funding to implement recommendations from the Oregon Nurse Staffing Advisory Board.

Providence is committed to developing collaborative partnerships with our nurse caregivers to improve work satisfaction and provide a better care experience for our patients. As part of these efforts Providence was a strong supporter of comprehensive, consensus nurse staffing legislation that passed in 2015.

Through our work with the Oregon Health Authority, hospitals statewide are implementing nurse staffing modernization changes but we have faced a number of unforeseen challenges. In order to address these challenges that Nurse Staffing Advisory Board crafted recommendations to improve the process as OHA enters the second tri-annual round of surveys. These recommendations include streamlining the survey process, educating surveyors and increasing their capacity, and strengthening the role of the Board.
