WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Removes requirements that grants for student transportation costs be prioritized for school districts that did not receive public moneys in the previous school year. Appropriates \$1,250,000 out of the General Fund for biennium ending on June 30. 2021. Takes effects on July 1, 2020.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-1 Reinstates requirement that grants for student transportation costs be prioritized for school districts that did not receive public moneys in the previous school year.

BACKGROUND:

House Bill 4130 (2018) established a matching grant fund for school districts to offset transportation costs. It allocated \$250,000 to fund the matching provision, allowing a dollar-for-dollar match.
