My name is Hilary Uhlig and I am submitting written support for HB 4145 - Addressing Threats to Schools and Places of Worship.

It is a sad fact that we live in a society where there is no safe place from the threat of violence. Malls, movie theaters, grocery stores... have all been places of mass shootings and threats of violence. While we cannot stop all threats from happening, there are some places that we should make every effort to mitigate the effects of possible violence. HB 4145 will prevent an escalation of violent behavior when someone makes threats of violence to a school or place of worship by ensuring those individuals gain access to mental health treatment and supervised probation.
