Southwest Airlines respectfully opposes House Bill 4036 as drafted, filed in the 2020 legislative session by the Joint Transportation Committee. Additionally, we support eliminating the 2022 sunset and retaining the existing tax without an additional increase. We believe that increasing the jet fuel tax could hurt an airlines' capacity to expand commercial air service in Oregon. The proposal strains an already intensely fuel-sensitive industry, making operating at Oregon airports more expensive, and increasing the cost burden on airlines and their customers.
