

Support House Bill 4016

House Bill 4016 maintains uniform senior care standards across Oregon and creates the Emergency Medical Services Innovation Pilot Project.

Uniform care standards are a critical component of a successful regulatory structure for long term care providers. If each municipality in the state wrote their own care standards, it would create a patchwork of differing regulations that would not serve the best interests of those receiving care and services.

The Emergency Medical Services Innovation Pilot Project will allow local EMS providers to receive funding to try different response strategies for long term care communities. A broad stakeholder advisory council will guide the program, with funding coming from the Department of Human Services' Quality Fund.
