Chair Salinas, Vice-Chairs Hayden and Nosse, and Representatives Alonso León, Drazan, Greenlick, Keny-Guyer, Moore-Green, Noble, Prusak, and Schouten:

The Oregon Commissions on Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs, Black Affairs, Hispanic Affairs, and Commission for Women, in their roles of policy advisors and advocates for under-represented communities across Oregon strongly support HB 4161 which defines the focus of the Regional Health Equity Coalitions (RHEC), and defines the OHA role in providing grants and needed technical assistance and program planning. This bill will ultimately improve the supports and targeted outcomes of these important coalitions as they work on behavior health policies, programs, resourcing, and outcomes in their areas; both urban and rural.

The model of RHEC's is based on local communities across Oregon and their individual and collective abilities to effect change and establish efforts that successfully address long standing challenges, and cultural stigmas, through culturally accessible and appropriate models. HB 4161 more clearly defines the impacted communities, the role of OHA, and the work and funding of the RHEC's around historically underserved communities.
