

**Department of State Lands  
Information Technology Assessment Report**

On February 10th, the Natural Resources Subcommittee recommended acknowledging receipt of a report from the Department of State Lands on comprehensive assessment of the agency's information technology related operations.

The Department of State Lands worked with Office of the State Chief Information Officer to produce an Information Resource Management Strategic Plan that included a comprehensive assessment as required by budget note. The plan provides a detailed analysis of the current state of information technology related operations that includes discussions of current systems, hardware, processes, and personnel. The assessment identified a number of issues and created a strategic framework with detailed objectives to resolve those issues. The agency and OSCIO are working cooperatively to develop an implementation plan to address the most immediate issues, and it is anticipated that the agency will include supporting budget adjustment requirements with its 2021-23 biennial budget request.

The report has also been presented and reviewed by the Joint Legislative Committee on Information Management and Technology, which adopted specific recommendations related to the report and transmitted those recommendations to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The Natural Resources Subcommittee recommends approval.
