I'm Dan Mulholland, from Eugene now, from Florence originally, K-12 student of Siuslaw School District. I've worked with 350 Eugene and Global Ocean Health on climate policy issues for many years. I'm here to tell you what to do; because no-one else ever does that.

In 1919, Oregon passed the nation's first fuel tax to pay for highways. 6 years later, 91% of the states had passed similar legislation. An Oregon climate law is not only about addressing Oregon's emissions, but also about encouraging other states to act.

My priority is passing a bill. The climate effort will go on for decades; this law will be modified to fit experience and circumstances. Getting started is what is required of us now.

Coming up with a measure with decent benefits compared to the costs, is the challenge, not making myself or other bill advocates happy. Both Timber Unity and Renew Oregon need a good climate bill.

Please make the compromises needed to maintain a quorum, get majority support, and pass a bill in 2020.
