To whom it may concern,

I would ask that as representatives of all Oregon citizens you strongly oppose any and all aspects of HB4167 as it is NOT good for Oregon at this point and time.

While the end target may be admirable, trying to accomplish such great goals takes planning and steps to reach such a goal. We are all concerned about our environment and the future that we leave for our children. But with the way this proposal is written will produce just the opposite of the intended effect as written today.

We in Oregon do not today have the building blocks in place to formally approach such a lofty goal that has been proposed in HB4167. While the proposal does state some exceptions to the enactment dates of legislation, I have yet to see any studies of what negative consequences might be without having the proper steps taken in advance of the final goal. But let's take it one step further: Of all of those businesses that will shut down and people migrate to cities how much Carbon Sequestration will be lost due to proper management of Oregon's Natural Recourses.?
