Lisa Rogers – CASA of Oregon Over the years, the Legislature has authorized several local option property tax exemptions for affordable housing, including ORS 307.515 and ORS 307.540. SB 1531 addresses the recent change made by the federal government to allow for more people of different income levels to be served by affordable housing. Housing Oregon supports the Legislature updating the local option property tax exemptions to align with this new criteria by including this update in SB 1531.

This change allows averaging of incomes of property occupants in determination of income for low-income rental and nonprofit low-income rental property tax exemptions if property is awarded tax credits through the federal Low-Income Housing Tax Credit Program.
