

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 4076

Relating to a task force on age discrimination

HB 4076 establishes the 11-member Task Force on Age Discrimination charged with identifying and evaluating the impact of age discrimination in the work place and making policy recommendations to deter age discrimination.

The Legislative Policy and Research Office is directed to provide staff support to the Task Force. The bill requires a representative of the Civil Rights Division of the Bureau of Labor and Industries to serve on the Task Force. The Task Force must submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature by September 15th, 2020. The Task Force sunsets on December 31st, 2021. The fiscal impact of the bill is anticipated to be minimal.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends HB 4076 be reported out do pass.
