Subject: SB 1573 – Relating to juvenile records
Work Session Recommendations

SB 1573 implements new requirements for the expunction of juvenile records. The bill requires juvenile departments to automatically expunge certain juvenile records after a person reaches the age of eighteen, creates immunity for juvenile departments performing expunction notifications, provides counsel for persons seeking to have their juvenile records expunged, and changes the penalty for releasing expunged information. SB 1573 requires the Oregon Youth Authority, in collaboration with the Oregon Judicial Department and county juvenile departments, to report back to the Legislature on the implementation of the bill and on recommended legislative changes to juvenile record expunction laws and processes. The bill takes effect on the 91st day after adjournment sine die.

The -A6 amendment removes a blank appropriation section from the measure.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A6 amendment.
