Subject: HB 4079-A – Relating to the universal service fund; prescribing an

effective date.

HB 4079-A establishes the Broadband Fund in the Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD). Monies in the Fund will be used to finance operations of the Oregon Broadband Office in OBDD, and to provide grants and loans for planning and constructing broadband infrastructure projects.

The measure extends the state universal service surcharge, currently assessed on telephone landlines, to cellphone and VOIP service charges for in-state voice calls. The measure also reduces the maximum surcharge rate from 8.5% to 6%. These changes become operative on January 1, 2021. The measure authorizes the Public Utility Commission to transfer up to \$5 million of universal service surcharge revenue to the Broadband Fund each year. The actual transfer amounts will be determined by the Commission. The provisions of the bill sunset on January 2, 2030.
