

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 1546

Relating to public safety

SB 1546 is a public safety omnibus bill that makes various changes to statutes pertaining to criminal justice.

Among other provisions, it outlines the notice and process requirements for firearms prohibitions resulting from convictions for qualifying misdemeanors and for convictions for stalking. In order to implement these provisions of the bill, the Law Enforcement Data System, or LEDS, operated by the Oregon State Police, must be modified in order to allow the entry of court orders relating to the prohibition on possessing firearms and ammunition as outlined in the bill. The recommended amendment appropriates \$115,000 General Fund on a one-time basis to the Oregon State Police to pay for the required LEDS modifications.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends SB 1546 be amended by the –A8 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
