Subject: HB 4163 – Relating to state financial administration (Program Change)

Work Session Recommendations

HB 4136 relates to state financial administration. An amendment replaces the bill. The amended version is referred to as the "Program Change" bill. The bill has an emergency clause and is effective on passage.

The bill as amended implements the statutory changes necessary to support the 2019-21 legislatively approved budget and to clarify the application of statutes. The bill is not an appropriation bill and therefore does not include the appropriation of funds.

The fiscal or budgetary impacts of provisions of this bill are contained in HB 5204 (budget reconciliation) and HB 5203 (Lottery Fund/Criminal Fines Account allocations) for the 2019-21 biennium, or in specific budget bills.

A preliminary staff measure summary, fiscal impact, and revenue impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

An -7 amendment replaces the bill.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -7 amendment.
