Measure Description:

Directs Department of Land Conservation and Development to study laws related to use of land and to report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2020.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD)

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Costs related to the measure are indeterminate at this time - See explanatory analysis.

Analysis:

HB 4050 directs the Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) to conduct a study of laws related to use of land in the state. DLCD is directed to submit findings to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly by September 15, 2020.

The fiscal impact from this bill is indeterminate, as the scope of this study, and desired outcomes, are unclear from the text of this measure. This bill could have a fiscal impact for DLCD, but more clarification is needed to determine the budgetary impacts of this measure.
