Provides that a city in Clackamas County annexed into county parks and recreation service district between January 1, 2005, and December 31, 2006, by vote of city electors is deemed withdrawn from and no longer part of county service district as of June 30, 2020.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

ORS 198.870 establishes a petition and approval process for the removal of property from a special district. House Bill 4106 would establish that a city in Clackamas County annexed into the county parks and recreation service district, deemed to be withdrawn from the county service district by vote of electors, be withdrawn from the county service district as of June 30, 2020.
