Measure Description:

Establishes eligibility for renewable energy certificates for facilities that generate electricity from direct combustion of municipal solid waste and became operational before January 1, 1995, if such facilities register with Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System at any time.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Energy (DOE), Public Utility Commission (PUC), Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Energy and Environment to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure establishes eligibility for renewable energy certificates for facilities that generate electricity from direct combustion of municipal solid waste.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on Department of Energy, Public Utility Commission and Department of Environmental Quality.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
