Impact Explanation:

As part of the funding mechanism for the program, this bill proposes a \$10.80 assessment each tax lot within ODF Protection Districts, applied consistently with ORS 477.277(1), paying the funds into the State Forestry Department Account. This would affect 157,632 of ODF's currently assessed improved lots, through the existing surcharge revenue stream. Oregon Department of Forestry estimates a 97% collection rate.
