# **Summary of Revenue Changes**

House Bill 4002 appropriates \$250,000 General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to be provided to the Homelessness Research and Action Collaborative at Portland State University (PSU) to conduct a study on long-term rental assistance.

## **Summary of Education Subcommittee Action**

House Bill 4002 requires the Homelessness Research and Action Collaborative, within the Toulan School of Urban Studies and Planning, at PSU to conduct a study on the costs and benefits and policy choices to provide long-term rental assistance to Oregonians experiencing severe rent burden or homelessness or who are at risk of homelessness. The bill stipulates what must be included within the study and requires the PSU to report to an appropriate interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than December 1, 2020.

The Subcommittee approved a one-time appropriation of \$250,000 to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to be distributed to PSU for the purposes of conducting the study.
