## **Summary of Revenue Changes**

House Bill 4072 increases Other Funds expenditure limitation by \$672,883 to the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) for the creation of the Oregon Hemp State Program. The Other Funds revenue supporting this program is primarily from hemp grower licenses, grow site fees, hemp handler licenses, and hemp seed producer licenses.

# **Summary of Natural Resource Subcommittee Action**

House Bill 4072 establishes Oregon Hemp State Program. The new program replaces the current hemp registration program at ODA.

House Bill 4072 directs ODA to adopt rules and implement a hemp program approved by the United States Department of Agriculture. Adequate staffing of the Oregon Hemp State Program's administrative and enforcement functions will be critical to gaining federal approval. To address the staffing needs, the Natural Resource Subcommittee recommended four permanent full-time positions (2.52 FTE). The positions include two Natural Resource Specialist 3's for field inspection and enforcement; an Office Specialist 2 for administrative functions such as application review and program support; and a Principal Executive Manager D for program oversight and statewide coordination. The Subcommittee recommendation of \$672,883 Other Funds includes \$135,000 Other Funds expenditure limitation for one-time start-up costs.
