Summary of Revenue Changes

Senate Bill 1513 provides a one-time appropriation of \$75,000 General Fund to the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) to adopt rules around the requirement that large confined animal feeding operations receive approval from the Department before construction or operation.

Summary of Capital Construction Subcommittee Action

Senate Bill 1513 requires ODA to provide approval as a prerequisite to the construction, installation, operation, or maintenance of a large confined animal feeding operation or a large concentrated animal feeding operation. ODA is required to confirm legal water supply and reliability prior to issuance of final approval by either the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) or ODA of a feeding operation. Currently, ODA and DEQ jointly issue individual permits for confined animal feeding operations. The measure allows both ODA and DEQ to charge a fee for granting approvals.

Senate Bill 1513 also requires an individual permit for a qualifying operation if it is either located in a ground water management area or if it applies animal waste to land. ODA will establish the fee amount for the permit by rule and fee revenue will be used for future administration of the measure.

To pay for costs related to rule making facilitation and outreach, the Subcommittee recommended a one-time \$75,000 General Fund appropriation. Any new fees established by rule for this program will require ratification by the Legislature.
