## **Summary of Revenue Changes**

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommended appropriating \$115,000 in one-time General Fund to the Department of State Police (OSP) to support modifications to the Law Enforcement Data System (LEDS).

# **Summary of Public Safety Subcommittee Action**

Senate Bill 1546 is a public safety omnibus bill that makes various changes to statutes pertaining to criminal justice. Sections 1-4 of the measure outline the notice and process requirements for firearm prohibitions resulting from convictions or qualifying midsdemeanors and for convictions for stalking. It directs the courts to enter orders prohibiting the defendant from possession of firearms and ammunition. The court shall transmit the orders to OSP and the applicable county sheriff. OSP and the county sheriff shall enter the orders into the relevant databases.

The one-time \$115,000 General Fund appropriated to OSP will be used to modify the LEDS database to accommodate the entry of the court orders relating to the prohibition on possessing firearms and ammunition.
