## **Summary of Revenue Changes**

House Bill 4149 appropriates \$200,000 General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority for the purposes of the bill.

#### **Summary of Capital Construction Subcommittee Action**

House Bill 4149 directs the Director of the Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission to work with the Director of the Oregon Health Authority and the Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction to develop an intervention strategy to address substance use among school-aged children and youth. This information must be reported to the Legislative Assembly by November 1, 2020.

House Bill 4149 also directs the Oregon Health Authority to work with the Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission to take an inventory of the resources available in this state to address the prevention of, treatment for, and recovery from substance use disorders. The inventory must identify the types and levels of recovery supports currently available and the amounts needed to meet the need for recovery support in the state, the barriers to providing the necessary levels of recovery supports, and other information describing the current level of services available in the state. This information must be reported to the Legislative Assembly by November 1, 2020.

The Subcommittee recommended \$200,000 General Fund be appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority on a one-time basis to produce the strategy and the report.
