

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4035

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 14, after “The” insert “Department of Revenue.”.
- 2 In line 15, after “Governor” insert “, in consultation with the Oregon Cannabis Commission and
3 licensees and other cannabis entities regulated by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission,”.
- 4 In line 27, delete “and”.
- 5 In line 28, delete the period and insert “;
- 6 “(h) Assess the financial impact of the tracking system described in ORS 475B.177 on licensees
7 as defined in ORS 475B.015 and the state and make recommendations to improve the tracking system
8 and reduce the cost of tracking to cannabis businesses in Oregon; and
- 9 “(i) Ensure the timely sharing of tax compliance data with cities, counties and the
10 commission.”.
- 11 Delete line 29 and insert:
- 12 “(2) The authority, departments, office of the Governor and Oregon Liquor Control Commission
13 shall submit the”.
- 14 On page 2, after line 3, insert:
- 15 **“SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2020 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475B.010 to
16 475B.545.**
- 17 **“SECTION 4. (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall adopt rules to develop
18 compliance education programs for licensees and cannabis entities regulated by the com-
19 mission. In adopting rules under this section, the commission shall consult with licensees
20 and other interested parties.**
- 21 **“(2) The rules adopted under this section must:**
- 22 **“(a) Clarify that participation in a compliance education program is voluntary;**
- 23 **“(b) Establish mitigation periods for certain violations, as determined by the commission,
24 of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.545 and rules adopted under ORS 475B.010 to 475B.545; and**
- 25 **“(c) Include that the commission may offer recommendations on the abatement of vio-
26 lations described in paragraph (b) of this subsection prior to taking any action specified in
27 ORS 475B.256.**
- 28 **“(3) The commission may adopt other rules as necessary to carry out this section.**
- 29 **“SECTION 5. (1) Section 4 of this 2020 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2021.**
- 30 **“(2) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may take any action before the operative
31 date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the commission to
32 exercise, on or after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the
33 duties, functions and powers conferred on the commission by section 4 of this 2020 Act.”.**
- 34 In line 4, delete “3” and insert “6”.
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
