## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Decreases biennial appropriation from General Fund to Department of Veterans' Affairs. Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Long Term Care Ombudsman for purpose of providing public guardian and conservator services to veterans. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to veterans; and prescribing an effective date. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

4 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation

made to the Department of Veterans' Affairs by section 1 (1), chapter 570, Oregon Laws 2019, 5

for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, for services provided by the department, is decreased 6 7 by \$\_\_\_

- 8 SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Long Term Care Ombudsman, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the 9 General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_ to create, fill and utilize three positions in support of the 10 Oregon Public Guardian and Conservator to provide public guardian and conservator services 11 12 exclusively to veterans. 13 SECTION 3. This 2020 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2020 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. 14

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
