

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4095

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “creating new”.
- 2 In line 3, delete “provisions;” and insert “amending section 9, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016;”
- 3 Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
- 4 “**SECTION 1.** Section 9, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016, is amended to read:
- 5 “**Sec. 9. (1)** The Land Conservation and Development Commission shall report on the progress
- 6 of the pilot program, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to the committees of the Legislative
- 7 Assembly related to housing and human services:
- 8 “[*1*] **(a)** At least once during each of [*three*] **eight** consecutive regular sessions of the Legisla-
- 9 tive Assembly, beginning with the 2017 regular session of the Legislative Assembly; and
- 10 “[*2*] **(b)** At least once following adjournment sine die of the regular sessions of the Legislative
- 11 Assembly described in [*subsection (1) of this section*] **paragraph (a) of this subsection**, but no later
- 12 than the convening of the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly.
- 13 “**(2) The report given during the 2022 regular session of the Legislative Assembly under**
- 14 **subsection (1)(a) of this section must include information regarding:**
- 15 “**(a) A summary and comparison of the experiences reported by the cities participating**
- 16 **in the pilot program;**
- 17 “**(b) An analysis of the potential effects of extending the pilot program statewide;**
- 18 “**(c) Whether a statewide implementation of the pilot program would significantly im-**
- 19 **prove the availability of housing units;**
- 20 “**(d) The extent to which criteria for compliance with the pilot program would be pro-**
- 21 **hibitive for other cities if the program were extended statewide; and**
- 22 “**(e) Suggestions for additions to or subtractions from the criteria for compliance with**
- 23 **the program and elements of the program if the pilot program were extended statewide and**
- 24 **the anticipated effects of implementing those suggestions.**
- 25 “**SECTION 2. (1) Sections 2, 3 and 5 to 8, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016, are repealed on**
- 26 **January 2, 2028.**
- 27 “**(2) Section 4, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016, as amended by section 1, chapter 32, Oregon**
- 28 **Laws 2019, is repealed on January 2, 2028.**
- 29 “**(3) Section 9, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016, as amended by section 1 of this 2020 Act,**
- 30 **is repealed on January 2, 2028.”.**
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
