SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits police officer from conducting or participating in activities intended to determine whether person has paid certain user charges, fees or tolls imposed by mass transit district.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to mass transit districts.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) A police officer may not conduct or participate in activities intended to**
5 **determine whether a person has paid user charges, fees or tolls imposed by a mass transit**
6 **district under ORS 267.320.**

7 **(2) Nothing in this section prohibits a police officer from enforcing laws that are not re-**
8 **lated to payment of user charges, fees or tolls imposed by a mass transit district under ORS**
9 **267.320.**

10 **(3) As used in this section, "police officer" has the meaning given that term in ORS**
11 **181A.355.**
