Senate Bill 1515

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs office of State Treasurer to research creation of wildfire workforce foundation and report to committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to wildfire no later than September 15, 2020.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

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- 2 Relating to wildfire; and declaring an emergency.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - **SECTION 1. (1) The office of the State Treasurer shall:**
 - (a) Conduct market, legal and fiscal research on the creation of a wildfire workforce foundation that receives private and public funds to support youth workforce development programs in the areas of forest restoration and wildfire reduction;
 - (b) Identify potential collaborators in the wildfire workforce foundation;
 - (c) Explore prospects for federal government support of the wildfire workforce foundation;
 - (d) Inventory the experiences and successes of existing wildfire workforce programs; and
 - (e) Create a case statement for potential donors to the wildfire workforce foundation.
 - (2) The office of the State Treasurer shall report on the results of the research and tasks performed under subsection (1) of this section to a committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to wildfire no later than September 15, 2020.
 - <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2020 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2020 Act takes effect on its passage.

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
