Senate Bill 1526

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Describes evidence that Health Licensing Office may consider to determine if applicant for residential care facility administrator license has earned high school diploma or equivalent.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to long term care; creating new provisions; amending ORS 678.733; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - **SECTION 1.** ORS 678.733 is amended to read:
- 6 678.733. (1) The Health Licensing Office may issue a residential care facility administrator li-7 cense to an applicant who:
 - (a) Is at least 21 years of age;

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- 9 (b) Has earned at least a high school diploma or its equivalent[;], as indicated by evidence of 10 the following, in a form deemed sufficient by the office:
 - (A) Completion of high school or an equivalent educational level;
 - (B) Passage of an approved high school equivalency test, including but not limited to the General Educational Development (GED) test; or
 - (C) Graduation from a post-secondary institution;
 - (c)(A) For at least two of the last five years has been employed in a professional or managerial capacity in a health or social service related field, or has a combination of experience and education deemed sufficient by the office; or
 - (B) Has earned at least a bachelor's degree in a health or social service related field;
- 19 (d) Has completed at least 40 hours of training approved by the office by rule;
- 20 (e) Pays a licensure fee; and
 - (f) Passes an examination described in ORS 678.743.
 - (2) Evidence of the education described in subsection (1)(b) of this section may be provided by a diploma or other document, or by facts, circumstances or other indicators deemed sufficient by the office.
- [(2)] (3) When issuing a license under this section, the office shall consider the qualifications for employment under ORS 443.004.
 - SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 678.733 by section 1 of this 2020 Act apply to residential care facility administrator license applications submitted to the Health Licensing Office on or after the effective date of this 2020 Act.
 - SECTION 3. This 2020 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

- peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2020 Act takes effect on its passage.
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
