

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1569

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 5 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 35, insert:

2 “(4) A person subject to discipline under this section is entitled to a contested case hearing in
3 accordance with ORS chapter 183.

4 “(5) The board is the agency responsible for providing notice and contested case hearing rights
5 under ORS chapter 183 to a person subject to discipline under this section.”.

6 On page 9, after line 38, insert:

7 “**SECTION 16. Operative date.** (1) Sections 1 to 11 of this 2020 Act, the amendments to
8 ORS 646.608 and 822.215 by sections 12 and 13 of this 2020 Act and the repeal of ORS 98.864
9 by section 14 of this 2020 Act become operative on January 1, 2021.

10 “(2) The members of the State Board of Towing may be appointed before the operative
11 date specified in subsection (1) of this section, and the board and the Department of Trans-
12 portation may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this
13 section that is necessary to enable the board and the department to exercise, on and after
14 the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, the duties, functions and powers
15 of the board and the department pursuant to sections 1 to 11 of this 2020 Act, the amend-
16 ments to ORS 646.608 and 822.215 by sections 12 and 13 of this 2020 Act and the repeal of ORS
17 98.864 by section 14 of this 2020 Act.

18 “**SECTION 17. Expenditure limitation.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expen-
19 ditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (9), chapter 614, Oregon Laws
20 2019, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses
21 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds
22 received as reimbursement from the United States Department of Transportation, but ex-
23 cluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 614, Oregon Laws
24 2019, collected or received by the Department of Transportation, for driver and motor vehicle
25 services, is increased by \$241,650 to carry out the provisions of sections 1 to 11 of this 2020
26 Act and the amendments to ORS 646.608 and 822.215 by sections 12 and 13 of this 2020
27 Act.”.
