PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4069

1 Delete lines 14 through 20 of the printed bill and insert:

"SECTION 2. (1) If the Water Resources Department requires an entity to measure the use of water diverted, stored or otherwise appropriated by the entity under a right established by a water right permit, water right certificate, limited license, decree, order of determination or ground water registration, the department may require the entity to report the measured use to the department.

"(2) The Water Resources Commission shall adopt rules as provided
under ORS 536.027 for the carrying out of subsection (1) of this section
by the department. In adopting rules under this subsection, the commission shall give consideration to:

"(a) The provision of waivers in cases where requiring the reporting
 of water use measurements would cause hardship;

14 "(b) The circumstances under which the reporting of water use
 15 measurements would facilitate the resolution of conflicts;

"(c) The extent to which the reporting of water use measurements
 would facilitate the evaluation of water resource availability;

"(d) The consistency of requiring the reporting of water use meas urements with the integrated state water resources strategy; and

20 "(e) How water use measurement data is or should be stored.

21 "(3) The commission shall make reporting requirements adopted

under subsection (2) of this section applicable only to water uses that
do not have reporting requirements otherwise established under a
water right permit or certificate, limited license, decree, order of determination, ground water registration or ORS 537.099 or 540.435.".
