PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4043

- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. (1)(a) As used in this section, 'water project' means
 a project to construct or reconstruct interceptors, treatment plants
 or other facilities that are necessary to:
- 6 "(A) Pump, treat and distribute drinking water; or
- 7 "(B) Collect, treat and dispose of liquid and solid waste.
- 8 "(b) 'Water project' does not include a project to maintain or repair 9 the facilities described in paragraph (a) of this subsection.
- "(2)(a) Notwithstanding an ordinance, resolution, rule or other law
 that prohibits, restricts or limits an evaluation, comparison or use of
 pipe or piping material for or in connection with a water project, a
 project manager or project engineer for the water project, in designing
 or setting specifications for the water project, shall consider using any
 pipe or piping material for the water project that meets current standards or performance specifications of:
- "(A) ASTM International, or the successor organization of ASTM International;
- 19 "(B) The American Water Works Association, or the successor or-20 ganization of the American Water Works Association;

"(C) The American National Standards Institute, or the successor

- organization of the American National Standards Institute;
- "(D) NSF International, or the successor organization of NSF International; or
- 4 "(E) A registered professional engineer.
- 5 "(b) Paragraph (a) of this subsection applies only to water projects 6 for which all or a portion of the funding consists of moneys appropri-7 ated directly or indirectly from the State Treasury.
- 8 "(3) Subsection (2) of this section does not:

- "(a) Limit the professional judgment, opinion, recommendation or specification of a registered professional engineer or the opinion, recommendation or specification of a water project's project manager with respect to a final decision concerning the appropriate pipe or piping materials for, or the performance of pipe or piping materials in connection with, a specific water project; or
- "(b) Apply to any final decision concerning the design or construction specifications that a registered professional engineer or the water project's project manager develops for a specific water project in consultation with a local government, as defined in ORS 174.116.
- "SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2020 Act applies to a water project for which a local government, as defined in ORS 174.116, drafts specifications or initiates a design on or after the operative date specified in section 3 of this 2020 Act.
- "SECTION 3. (1) Section 1 of this 2020 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2021.
- "(2) A local government, as defined in ORS 174.116, may adopt, amend, enact or repeal an ordinance, resolution, rule or other law before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the local government to conform, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, to the requirements set forth in section 1 of this 2020 Act.

"SECTION 4. This 2020 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2020 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".
